

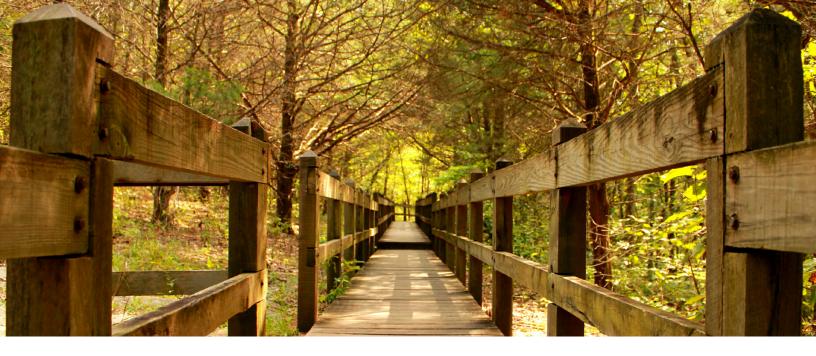




# NATURE'S BEAUTY

## **Start Your Day**

Before you head out on the trails, stop at **Broadway Diner**, a local favorite. Go on to the **MKT Nature and Fitness Trail**. This 8.9-mile trail goes through downtown Columbia and on to the Katy Trail.

Bridge Memorial
State Park and go all
the way down to the

caves and even more.

# **Picturesque**

With over five miles of nature trails, the **Grindstone Nature Area** offers a leashfree area for your canine trail buddy and prairie areas filled with wildflowers. It's a photo-worthy place to hike through.

### Stop & Stare

For a more scenic walk, visit **Shelter Gardens**. This fiveacre garden features a 19th century replica one-room schoolhouse, a garden for the visually impaired and a waterfall and stream.
