Willie's & Fieldhouse - An iconic destination for college students, visitors alumni, and locals, offering good food, great drinks, pool, and a unique multi-bar setting. - 1107 E Broadway	The Blue Note - A historic downtown theater hosting live music, stand-up comedy, dance parties, movies, and private events. - 17 N 9th St.
Rose Music Hall - A live music venue on the edge of downtown Columbia featuring indoor and outdoor stages, a huge patio, and food pop-ups inside. - 1013 Park Ave.	Billiards on Broadway - A local sports bar with plenty of TVs, 10 pool tables, and serving up some of the best burgers and fries in town. - 514 E Broadway
Deuce Pub & Pit - A sports-centric hub on the south side of town with bar food, happy hours, darts, pool, and a patio with a volleyball court. - 3700 Monterey Dr.	The Social Room - An old-school speakeasy-style lounge that doubles as both a late-night eatery and dance club. - 220 N 8th St.
The Roof - A bar and lounge located on top of The Broadway Hotel featuring great drinks, good food, weekend DJs, and one of the best views in the city. - 1111 E Broadway	Silverball - A downtown bar, arcade, and dance club wrapped into one, offering alcoholic slushees and endless arcade games. - 122 S 9th St.
My House - A combination sports bar and high energy nightclub that also operates the outdoor sports venue, The Backyard, in downtown Columbia 119 S 7th St.	The Vault - Located on the lower level of voco The Tiger Hotel The Vault is a modern speakeasy known for its award winning cocktails and inviting lounge. - 23 S 8th St.
Harpo's - A decades-old CoMo favorite featuring six full service bars, an all-season rooftop, and a lively nightclub. - 29 S 10th St.	Shiloh Bar & Grill - A restaurant and bar located in the historic Katy Station bulding in downtown Columbia with a spacious interior and sprawling patio. - 122 S 9th St.
